The NRRC aims to enhance the implementation of the QC programs in facilities performing medical exposures. A prerequisite to achieve this objective was to evaluate the current status of the implemented QC programs and identify potential areas for improvement.

Therefore, the NRRC has conducted a study to evaluate the status of the QC Programs implemented in facilities performing medical exposure around the Kingdom and identify the areas of improvement.

This study supports the development of the National Protocols for QC which aim to harmonize the QC protocols applied in medical facilities and ensure effective performance of medical radiological equipment.

The NRRC has established specific regulations for the implementation of QC programs in diagnostic radiology, nuclear medicine, and radiotherapy facilities to monitor the level of implementation of QC programs in facilities performing medical exposures
