



# National Legal Regulatory Framework

The Kingdom has joined a set of multilateral treaties and agreements to serve its interests in areas related to nuclear regulatory affairs. It is also committed to a number of international resolutions and codes.

The NRRC is responsible for fulfilling the Kingdom's obligations to the requirements of international instruments. These obligations include, but are not limited to, the preparation of national reports, participation in international review conferences and review meetings of these treaties and agreements, resolutions, and codes of conduct, to which the Kingdom is committed or politically supported.
